

## Labor Safety as a Tool For Comprehensive Management of the Food Sector.

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## ABSTRACT

When analyzing Knowledge Management immersed in the context of occupational safety as the fundamental basis for the performance of new integral managements, it is important to consider that no company can remain inert in the application and compliance with the regulations established through the legal bases indicated in the Organic Law of Prevention of Conditions and Work Environment (Lopcymat), in this sense the investigation is directed to the Venezuelan Food Producer and Distributor SA, located in the Municipality of Barinas, Barinas State, in order to strengthen knowledge and be able to align itself with the labor safety statutes considering each management position as a starting factor. The research was focused on a descriptive field and documentary study. The population was made up of eighteen (18) workers who were members of the management of the business entity. For data collection, the survey technique and a questionnaire-type instrument with closed questions were applied after validity and reliability. Although the company has a centralized workplace safety department, there is evidence of partial ignorance in this area, as a preliminary result, there is a marked weakness in each coordination in the management of the necessary knowledge of the workplace safety regulations, based on the new comprehensive management.
