Strategies To Strengthen The Respect of the National National Symbols In The Boys And Girls of the "José Laurencio Silva" Basic School

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ABSTRACT

The national identity begins with the formation of the citizen towards respect for the national symbols. The objective of this article is to propose strategies for strengthening respect for the national patriotic symbols in the boys and girls of the "José Laurencio Silva" Basic School. The scientific concern was framed in the weaknesses towards the habits in civic education, since hardly when singing the national anthem do the boys and girls adopt a behavior appropriate to the national symbol, just as they do not know how they should act before them.
