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Productive Yards as an Integrating Element in Students, Family, School and Community

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ABSTRACT

The performance of school institutions depends on their ability to find elements to integrate students, family, school and community, with productive playgrounds being an alternative to achieve this. The study highlighted the purpose of moving towards a productive economic force, immediate work, increasing production, strengthening the food system of our students through the School Feeding Program, without forgetting that the work must be done collectively, aimed at strengthening this program. Developing for this purpose the general objective: Propose the productive patios as an integrating element in students, family, school and community in the Basic School "José Laurencio Silva" Tinaco Cojedes state. Concluding that planting has not been given with a greater proportion due to the lack of integration and interest, by external and internal actors due to lack of commitment in the care and maintenance of the productive patios.
