Approach to a Historical Reconstruction of the Vicario III Neighborhood, Casco Central II, in the Francisco de Miranda Municipality of the Guárico State, from a Perspective of its Milestones, in Time 1980-2018

ABSTRACT

The importance of the recovery of the historical memory for the intervention of the social fabric of the neighborhoods, lies in the social reconstruction of the same, rescuing the identity and valuing the adaptation power that the territories have. The purpose of this documentary research, descriptive bibliohemerographic is to apply rationality and the understanding of phenomena as the epistemological basis of any dissertation, to know and describe the geohistorical space of the Vicario III Casco Central II neighborhood, in the Francisco de Miranda municipality of Guárico state, through a process of Historical reconstruction specifying the milestones or events that take place in its future as an urban sector in a certain period (1980-2018), to finally understand its universe with a criterion of totality in a coherent and systematic plane. This reconstruction process was carried out through the critical analysis of the dimensions of historical time and the content analysis of the social, economic and political processes that interacted with the social dynamics of the city of Calabozo in the state of Guárico, out from the corroboration of the data obtained in the documentary sources with the life histories collected from the inhabitants of the sector. As a result were studied the local historical processes that allowed the inhabitants of the neighborhood to consolidate themselves as a community and establish particular and diverse cultural characteristics. The participation of the community with the author of this work, allowed a broad reading of the urban space in the midst of an articulation within the categories of the historical, neighborhood and local context.
