ABSTRACT

The general purpose of the study is to: Explain the contributions offered by justice of the peace as significant for conciliation and harmonious preservation of community coexistence in the urbanization of Santa Inés in the San Fernando municipality of Apure State. The research was approached from the interpretative paradigm with a qualitative approach and the hermeneutic method; having as a scenario the community of the Santa Inés de San Fernando de Apure urbanization. To collect the information, participant observation and in-depth interview were used, using a notebook and a script as an instrument; with 5 informants. For the analysis of the information, categorization was used, followed by structuring, to then resort to triangulation and finally theorization. The validity and credibility are based on the triangulation of the findings. The results show that: Justice of the peace as a feasible mechanism to overcome and solve any dispute that may arise in the community context. Some members of the house of peace have been strengthening their communication and training mission on the benefits and conciliatory effects that can be achieved mediated by a justice of the peace. For its part, it was possible to conclude that: The mechanisms that the house of peace of the community of Santa Inés can use, will contribute significantly to resolve small disputes or disagreements that occur in the community context as a result of the diversity of thoughts, ideologies and religious tendencies.
