ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research was to generate a theoretical contribution aimed at the construction of a Cosmovision in the postgraduate course of Gynecology and Obstetrics of the Hospital "Dr. José María Carabaño Tosta" based on its social actors, with the intention of making visible what happens within these spaces. To this end, the qualitative paradigm was used through the ethnographic method supported by field research to create a realistic and faithful image of the group of actors studied. The scenario under study was represented by the "Dr. José María Carabaño Tosta" Hospital, located in Maracay. On the other hand, there were three reporting subjects: facilitator and postgraduate participant; as well as a user who demands the service. In relation to data collection techniques, they were participant observation and interview; Subsequently, the analysis and categorization of information was carried out, from which the construction of the theory emerged. In this sense, and considering the conclusions of the general matrix, it is intended to present the worldview of doing that must prevail in the development of this postgraduate course and that is aimed at the transformation of the being to achieve doing. The three people interviewed agreed on the need to improve postgraduate studies from a human point of view; There is no group cohesion according to what was expressed by the two informants who work in the center, while the person outside it (the user), also considered the need to assume the commitment and be aware of the work carried out.
