## ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the leadership skills needed to promote innovative entrepreneurship with a business sustainability focus, from an educational management perspective. A qualitative bibliographical documentary methodology was used, based on a critical review of authors such as Drucker, Mintzberg, Elkington, Kuratko, Ries, and Arzeni, among others. The results show a consensus on the importance of integrating management competencies, strategic leadership, change management, and ethical decision-making, with principles of social and environmental responsibility. In addition, toward active methodologies, real-world project-based learning, experimental models such as Lean Startup are identified. The discussion reveals that, although there is a solid theoretical foundation, gaps persist in educational implementation, especially in teacher training and institutional engagement with regional entrepreneurial ecosystems. The conclusions indicate that educational systems must be reformulated to train leaders capable of managing viable, innovative, and sustainable ventures, promoting comprehensive curricula, innovative methodologies, and educational policies aligned with the global challenges of the 21st century.
