Abstract

The purpose of this essay is to offer the state of the art of the author's doctoral thesis, from theoretical approaches to understand the Epistemic Network of Agroecotourism in Sustainable Development in the Mantecal Modules, Apure State, to achieve it, it is considered to perceive the sustainability from the multi-referentiality of the producers in the Agroecological Modules, to understand the ontological multiversality of sustainability, to discover the epistemic relationality of the strategic management of the producers, starting from the theoretical network that inserts the theories: General de Sistemas de Bertanalaffy (1954), Complexity of Morín (2000), Transdisciplinarity of Babarescu (1999) and Transcomplexity of Lanz (2002), following the postpositivist paradigm, from a hermeneutic vision, considering the methodical hermeneutics of Kockelmans (1975) suggested by Martínez (2009) perceive the autonomy of the object, interpretation of the phenomenon to the maximum in the reasonable and human, familiarize with the phenomenon in all its complexity, show the meaning of the phenomenon for the general situation, and apply the Hermeneutic Circle, whose procedure considered dialectical articulates the meaning of the parts, previous knowledge of the whole, finally proceed to develop theoretical approaches that allow us to understand the epistemic network of sustainable agroecotourism; whose reflections indicate that the aforementioned network is made viable through the productive eidos of each one of the producers, to satisfy their economic needs, for which reason the deep social commitment must be made aware even of themselves from the ecological-agricultural and tourist triad, for which should seek inter-community and intra-institutional links to realize them, providing and articulating the best development paths, such as the image of public policies consistent with the Plan of the Homeland 2019-2025.
