

Managerial Vision Of The Health Professional On The Attention To The Pregnant Woman In The Prenatal Consultation: A Perception From The Actors In The Urban Ambulatory Type I "Nueva Taborda" Puerto Cabello Carabobo State

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ABSTRACT

The present investigation was carried out in the prenatal consultation of the Urban Ambulatory Type I "Nueva Taborda" where socio-cultural, infrastructure and human resource factors were evidenced, which constitute difficulties for adequate health care. With the purpose of unveiling the managerial vision of the health professional on the care of the pregnant woman, this study was conceived within the post-positivist and interpretive paradigm, with a qualitative, phenomenological hermeneutical method, in which the theories were addressed: management according to Terry, Kristen Swanson's theory of care and theory of perception according to the Gestalt. Likewise, three (3) health professionals were chosen as key informants to whom a semi-structured interview was conducted. We proceeded to categorize the information obtained from it, integrating the findings through interpretation and understanding. The information was analyzed from the structuring, contrasting and triangulation, extracting as a reflection that the health care of the pregnant woman is mediated by education, this being a process in which knowledge is acquired that facilitate the integration of skills and habits. Prenatal control is the consultation of the pregnant woman that contributes to reduce maternal and infant morbidity and mortality. The administrative processes and the knowledge of the programs of the mother project, are of great importance in the prenatal control, being key in the management of the necessary resources for the quality of life of the pregnant women.
